MODULE ONE: FIRE SAFETY AWARENESS

- Healthcare fire safety / fire safety awareness.
- Fire emergency protocol (RACE) Action in the event of fire.
- Understanding installed building fire systems – FIP, EWIS, Emergency Lighting, and Manual Call Points etc.
- Identification and safe working practices of portable and fixed, firefighting equipment.

MODULE TWO: PRINCIPLES OF A STAGED EVACUATION

- Understanding, the purpose of fire and smoke compartmentation.
- Understanding the principles involved in the three stages of evacuation.
- Patient and resident removal prioritisation and Non Ambulant removal techniques.
- Staff to Resident / Patient Ratio.

MODULE THREE: EVACUATION EXERCISE

- A simulated fire emergency where staff members 'role play' patients or residents and on duty staff. The purpose is to test the facilities fire emergency procedures and staff actions.
